DSAL is pleased to announce the following scholarship program for families seeking support to offset expenses incurred while traveling to and participating in national conventions associated with Down syndrome.

For 2007, the total amount available for scholarships is \$2000 and one family can receive up to \$1000. Scholarships are available to any active dues paying DSAL member in good standing.

The following criteria must be met to apply for funding for one family member to participate in the National Down Syndrome Association (NDSS) or National Down Syndrome Congress (NDSC) convention this summer.

- Recipient must be an active DSAL member and have all dues current.
- One person per family will be sent to the convention.
- Person must be a parent, grandparent, or legal guardian of a child or grandchild with Down syndrome.
- Participant must give a presentation to the general membership of the latest techniques and information learned at the convention.
